- Journal (No spiral or metal wire please)
- Reading Material (Please remove any staples in magazines or books)
- Three days of clothing in disposable bag only (Washers/Dryers are available at KPH)
- Tobacco Products (18 years of age or older only)
- Make-up (No glass bottles or mirrors in cases) Adults Only
- Shoes appropriate for recreation therapy. Slip-on / no laces only (Or one 6" tie on top eyelets only)
- Approved Medications
- Money (No more than \$20 in dollar bills or quarters ONLY)

We Will Provide:

- Toothbrush/Toothpaste
- Soap
- Shampoo
- Combs
- Deodorant
- Lotion

Following are items that CANNOT be brought into Kingwood Pines Hospital

- Cameras, audio/visual recording devices of any kind
- Cell Phones and Pagers
- Metal Cans
- Guns or Other Weapons
- Knives or other sharp Objects
- Hangers of any type
- Clothing with drawstrings
- Lighters, Matches, Flammable Liquids or Sprays, Aerosol Cans
- Wire or Spiral Notebooks
- Glass Items, including Mirrors and Vases
- No Shoe Laces or Belts
- Vulgar, Offensive, or Provocative Clothing
- Sexually Explicit Materials
- Nail Clippers or Razors
- Any Items containing Alcohol
- Fingernail Polish
- Perfume or Aftershave (Unless in Plastic Bottles)
- Hats, Caps, or Bandanas
- CDs/CD Players, Walkmans, Headphones, Radios, Televisions or DVD Players
- Computers, Computer Disks, Laptops or Computer Games
- Electronic Games: Play Station, Game Boy, Nintendo, etc...
- Bar soap
- Curling Irons, Flat Irons, Hair Dryers
- Suitcases, Duffle Bags
- Excess Shoes
- Spray Cans
- Blankets & Pillows
